Play blocks with your child.

Draw a picture and tell a story about it.

Sing a lullaby before bedtime.



Do a chore together. Explain to your child how it gets accomplished.

Play dress up!

Sing the ABC song.

Dance with your child.

Read a book about a favorite animal.

Make a snack together by using a recipe from a cookbook.

Make up your own fairytale.

Look through a family album.

Take a walk. Talk about what you see.

Make animal noises together.

Have a picnic in your yard or house. Talk about what you see.

Read a book about colors.

Read a bedtime story.

Read your favorite childhood book to your child!

Sing "Itsy Bitsy Spider" with finger actions.



Read a nonfiction (true) book with your child.

Read a fairytale. Act one out.

Sing counting songs such as "One, Two, Buckle My Shoe."

Dance with your child.

Read a wordless book.

"Adopt" a stuffed animal pet. Talk about how to care for it.
