



**Henry C. Hatashita House – 1408 Pioneer Road**

The Henry C. Hatashita House was built in 1927 and was historically part of the Marland Mansion estate located to the northeast. The residence is cruciform shaped with a cross-gabled tile clad roof and is also clad in the same rusticated stone quarried nearby and used at the Marland Mansion. Henry C. Hatashita came to Ponca City, Oklahoma in 1918 at the request of oil man, E.W. Marland. He would remain in the city, working for Marland until 1939. He left behind a living legacy in the Ponca City landscape and is locally considered a “horticultural wizard.” During his time in Ponca City, he would oversee the transformation of a small pioneer town into what some considered “the beauty spot of the southwest.”
