



Pioneer Bible Church fka First Church of Christ Scientist

Designed in 1933 in the Federal style by prominent architect John Duncan Forsyth, Pioneer Bible Church is one story with a basement and is approximately seventy-six feet by forty-five feet. The asphalt shingled roof is end-gabled and has a small cupola toward the west end. The walls are rough-cut limestone blocks laid in regular courses. Unlike the majority of churches in Ponca City, Pioneer Bible Church, originally the First Church of Christ Scientist, retains its historic appearance on the east, south, and west elevations. The north, or rear, elevation has a large 1990s metal ramp to comply with current federal regulations.
